## CODE OF CONDUCT

Restaurant diners shall abide by all rules and regulations of the Club. The personnel of the Club have full authority to enforce these rules. Violation of any of these rules and/or inappropriate conduct may result in refusal of service.

- The dress code must be abided by.
- All food and beverages consumed within the Club facilities must be furnished by the Club.
- Dogs or other pets (with the exception of service dogs) are not permitted on the Club grounds, except under special circumstances or with permission of the management.
- All employees must be treated with courtesy.
- Only licensed vehicles are permitted on the Club grounds.
- Smoking is NOT permitted in any area of The Club.
- Use of cellular phones is permitted only in exterior areas of the Club away from other members and guests audible range and must be carried on silent or vibrate mode.
- The use of portable audio or visual systems without personal headsets is not permitted at the Club.
- Photographs or video recording is not permitted.
- Inappropriate behavior, language and profanity is not accepted at the Club.
- The splitting of checks or use of more than one form of payment is not permitted.

### DRESS CODE

It is expected that diners dress in a fashion befitting to the surroundings and atmosphere provided in the environment of the restaurant. During lunch hours Club casual attire such as golf shirts, T-shirts, shorts, sundresses, skirts and similar apparel are appropriate. After 6:00 p.m. club upscale attire such as collared shirts, golf shirts, dress T-shirts, dress shorts, jeans or slacks, sundresses, skirts and similar apparel are required. Bathing suits, athletic shorts and tank tops are not permitted attire for the restaurant facilities and shoes/sandals must be worn at all times.
